CURRENCY EXCHANGE

Local currency is the Pacific Franc or Franc CFP (XPF). In July 2017, the exchange rate was about AUD 1 for 80 CFP. Be careful, check the current rate in the shops because it moves with the stock market. You can change currency at banks (open Mondays to Fridays, from 8 am to 3:45 pm) or at ATMs indicated on the map.

PAYMENT

VISA and MASTERCARD are accepted but keep some cash with you for small shops (snacks, gift shops, etc.) and outside of Noumea. AMERICAN EXPRESS is accepted by some shops but cash withdrawal is not possible with it.

SHOPPING

You can buy gifts at Noumea's municipal market at Port Moselle and around Coconut Square. DUTY FREE Shops (usually open from 9 am to 5 pm) are indicated on the map: Noumea Duty Free, Marlene, Deci Dela Leatherwork, Rozanne Beauty Passion....

TRANSPORT

You can travel by Karuia public bus (1 ticket on board = CFP 210), make a hand signal to the bus driver at the bus stop to get on. You can also take a taxi (Call. 28 35 12) or guided tours (little trains, tour buses, etc.). Beware, Karuia Bus and taxis only accept Pacific Francs (CFP).

DINING

New Caledonia is a unique mix of French, Pacific and Asian cuisine. Meals are usually served from 11:30 am to 1:30 pm and from 7 pm to 9 pm. Tipping is not necessary in New Caledonia and all taxes are included in the price.

WI-FI

You can find free Wi-Fi in about fifteen places, such as the Maritime Station, Coconut Square and the Municipal Market. There are also internet cafés in the city centre of Noumea.

TOILETS

In Noumea, you will find public and free toilets in the Maritime Station and at Coconut Square. Toilets & showers are free-to-use on the Isle of Pines between Kuto Bay and Kanumera Bay. Look at the map for more details.
