

## **CURRENCY EXCHANGE**

Local currency is the Pacific Franc or Franc CFP (XPF). In July 2017, the exchange rate was about AUD 1 for 80 CFP. Be careful, check the current rate in the shops because it moves with the stock market. You can change currency at banks (open Mondays to Fridays, from 8 am to 3:45 pm) or at ATMs indicated on the map.



#### **TRANSPORT**

You can travel by Karuïa public bus (1 ticket on board = CFP 210), make a hand signal to the bus driver at the bus stop to get on. You can also take a taxi (Call. 28 35 12) or guided tours (little trains, tour buses, etc.). Beware, Karuïa Bus and taxis only accept Pacific Francs (CFP).



#### WI-FI

You can find free Wi-Fi in about fifteen places, such as the Maritime Station, Coconut Square and the Municipal Market. There are also internet cafés in the city centre of Noumea.

#### **TOILETS**

In Noumea, you will find public and free toilets in the Maritime Station and at Coconut Square. Toilets & showers are free-to-use on the Isle of Pines between Kuto Bay and Kanumera Bay. Look at the map for more details.



#### **PAYMENT**

VISA and MASTERCARD are accepted but keep some cash with you for small shops (snacks, gift shops, etc.) and outside of Noumea. AMERICAN EXPRESS is accepted by some shops but cash withdrawal is not possible with it.
