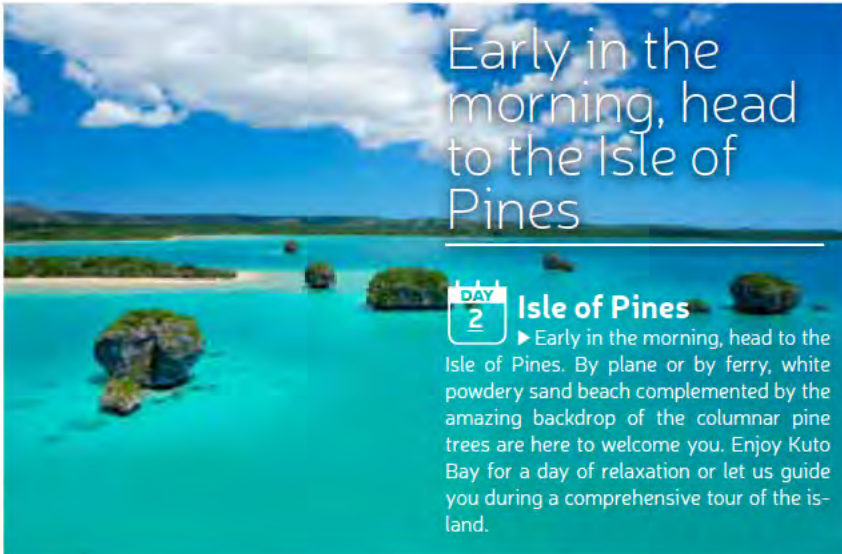
A SHORT AND ACTIVE STAY

Nouméa

► [The Nouméa markets](#) of Port Moresse is a daily celebration of the Pacific flavours. Mangoes, papayas, fresh fish and local crafts are available across colourful stands. Mix in with the locals and have your breakfast at la 'buvette du marché'. Then head off to the [city centre](#) for some well deserved shopping before visiting the [Aquarium of the Lagoons of New Caledonia](#) on Ansa Vata Bay.

► Early in the morning, head to the Isle of Pines. By plane or by ferry, white powdery sand beach complemented by the amazing backdrop of the columnar pine trees are here to welcome you. Enjoy Kuto Bay for a day of relaxation or let us guide you during a comprehensive tour of the island.

► Discover the majestic [Upi Bay](#) on a traditional outrigger sailing above the beautiful corals. Walk through dense forest and reach the mythical [natural swimming pool](#) of Oro. Complete your day with a lunch facing the beautiful [bay of Kanuméra](#) before coming back to Nouméa.



The Great South

► Only a one hour and a half drive from Nouméa, [the Yaté Lakes](#) contrast greatly with the red soils landscapes and lush vegetation preserved from millions of years of evolution. In the [Blue River Park](#), you will encounter the famous cagou bird. Or take a full moon kayak trip of the [drowned forest](#), a mystical excursion!
