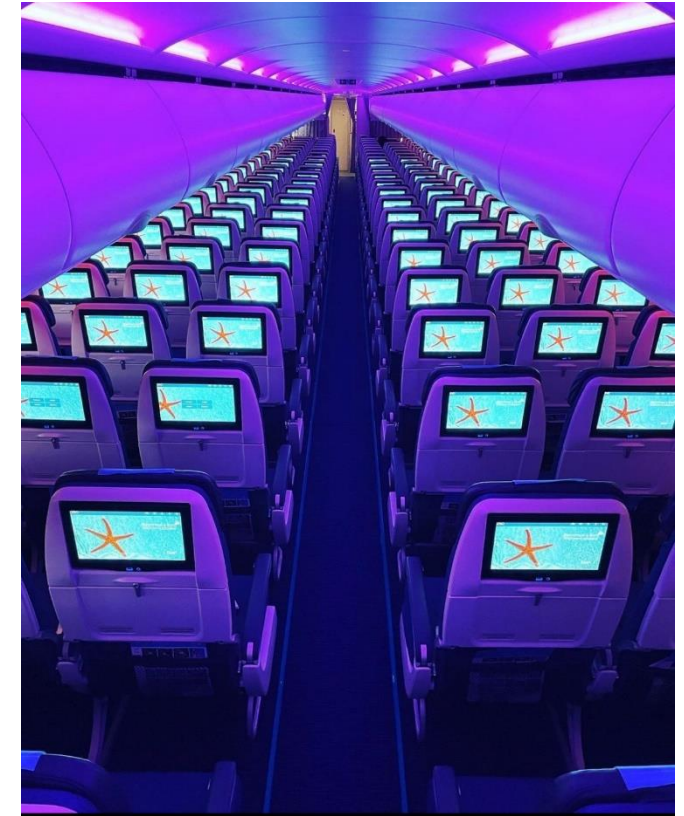

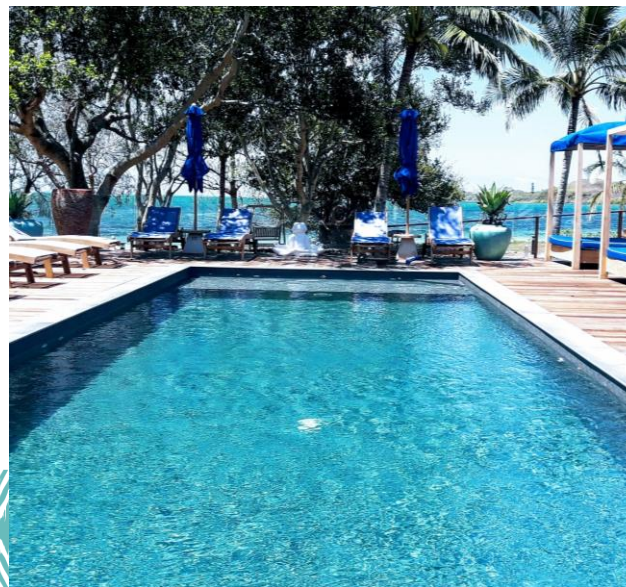

- Stop along the way and meet locals

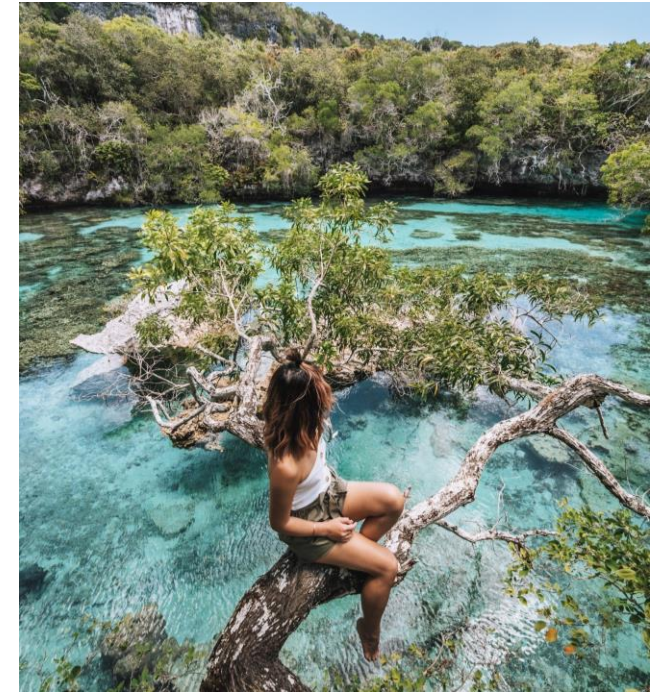
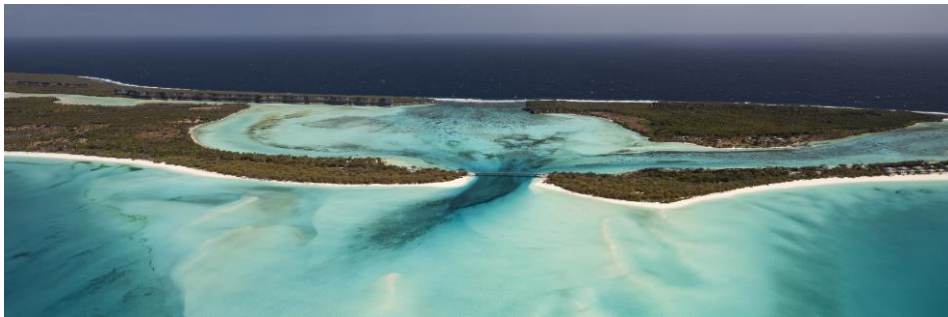

- Attend a local festival such as Vanilla festival, the Loyalty Islands Festival



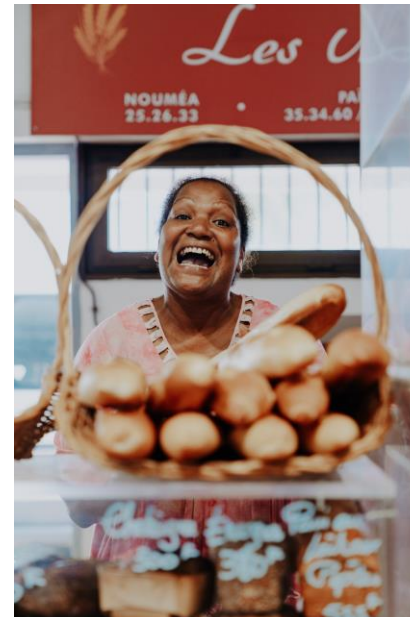

French Wine - \$9

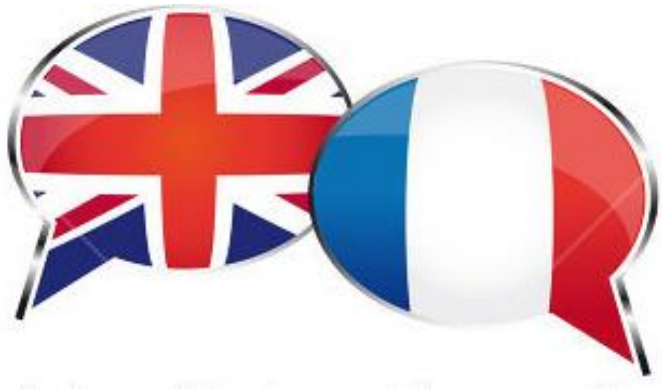
